Alternatives to Conflict Resolution

There are numerous alternatives to conflicts, but the primary forms appear to be either through litigation, arbitration, or mediation. The first two forms are based upon an adversarial model with a "judgement" deciding the conflict.

Mediation, to the contrary, allows for the parties to the conflict to fashion their own resolution with a neutral third party - the mediator - assisting by facilitating discussion though thoughtful, courteous exploration of issues and options.

Why Mediation?

Mediation is an alternative approach to resolving conflicts. It is compared to other forms of resolution, such as arbitration or litigation, favorably -

1. It is strictly voluntary;
2. The parties to the conflict are in control;
3. Any party may withdraw at any time;
4. Communications are confidential;
5. There is no "decision" by a Judge, Arbitrator, or other party;
6. The parties determine what the resolution will be; and
7. A timely resolution of the conflict rather than protracted expensive litigation.
